

# HAMMERHEAD CRAFT

## MATERIALS:

- 2 sheets of letter size paper
- Scissors
- Clear tape
- Shark pieces
- Gemstones, eyes or preferred decorations
- Glue

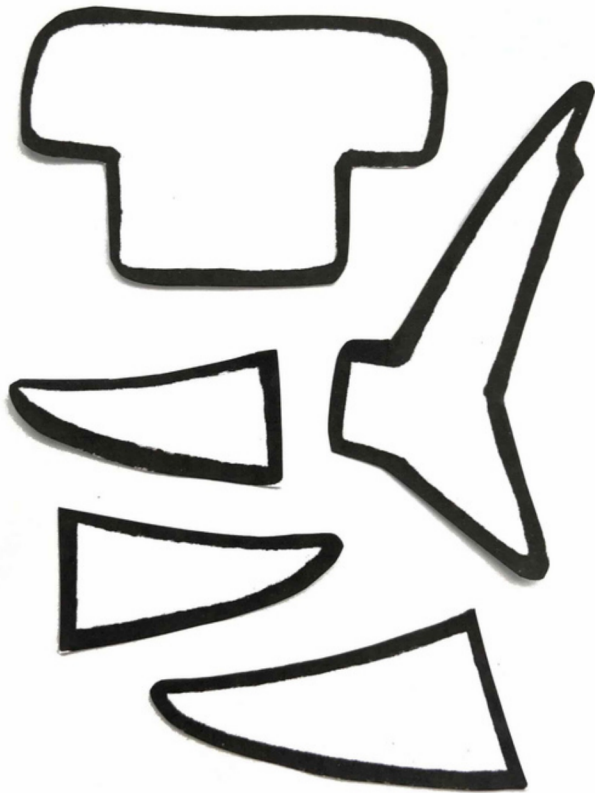
## Instructions:

- 1- Roll two sheets of paper one on top of the other until a "tube" is formed. Secure with tape.
- 2- Grab your sheet of paper containing your shark's pieces! You should have a **cephalofoil** (head), left and right **pectoral fins**, a **caudal fin** (tail) and a **dorsal fin**. Carefully cut the hammerhead pieces or ask an adult to help out!
- 4- Place the cephalofoil on the opening located at the front portion of the shark's body (tube). Glue to the bottom of the opening and then glue the top. At this point, it should look flattened.
- 5- Cut one vertical slit in the back of the shark and glue the caudal fin.
- 6- Place and glue the remaining fins (dorsal and pectoral).
- 7- Decorate and name your hammerhead!

# Meet your hammerhead!



Pieces:

Cephalofoil  
Pectoral fins (two)  
Dorsal fn  
Caudal fin

**PLEASE CUT CAREFULLY!**

Tip: When you're ready to glue the pectoral and dorsal fins, fold this portion in order to glue a flat surface.
