



OCEANIC WHITETIP

(*CARCHARHINUS LONGIMANUS*)



STATUS: Listed as 'Critically Endangered' on the IUCN Red List due to overfishing in pelagic fisheries around the world.



Global Distribution (IUCN Red List)

DIET: Primarily bony fish like barracuda, mahi-mahi, marlin, tuna and mackerel.

REPRODUCTION: They give birth to live young after 9-12 months of pregnancy. The average litter size is 5-6 pups.



SIZE: Can reach 3.5-3.95 m (11-13 ft).
