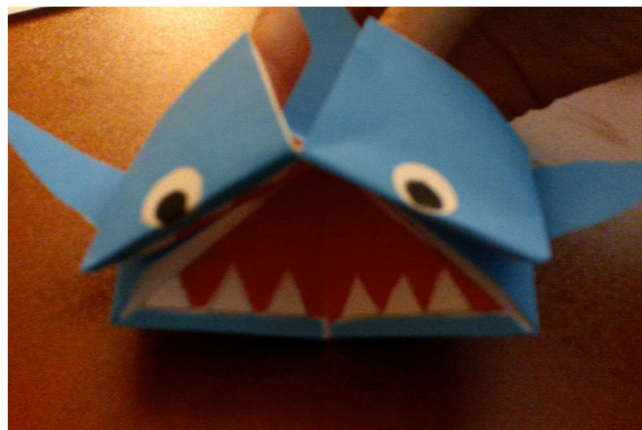


JAWSOME SHARK ORIGAMI

Origami fortune tellers or cootie catchers are a fun and easy activity. Best part is, they can be turned into creative games, animals or anything else your imagination can come up with.

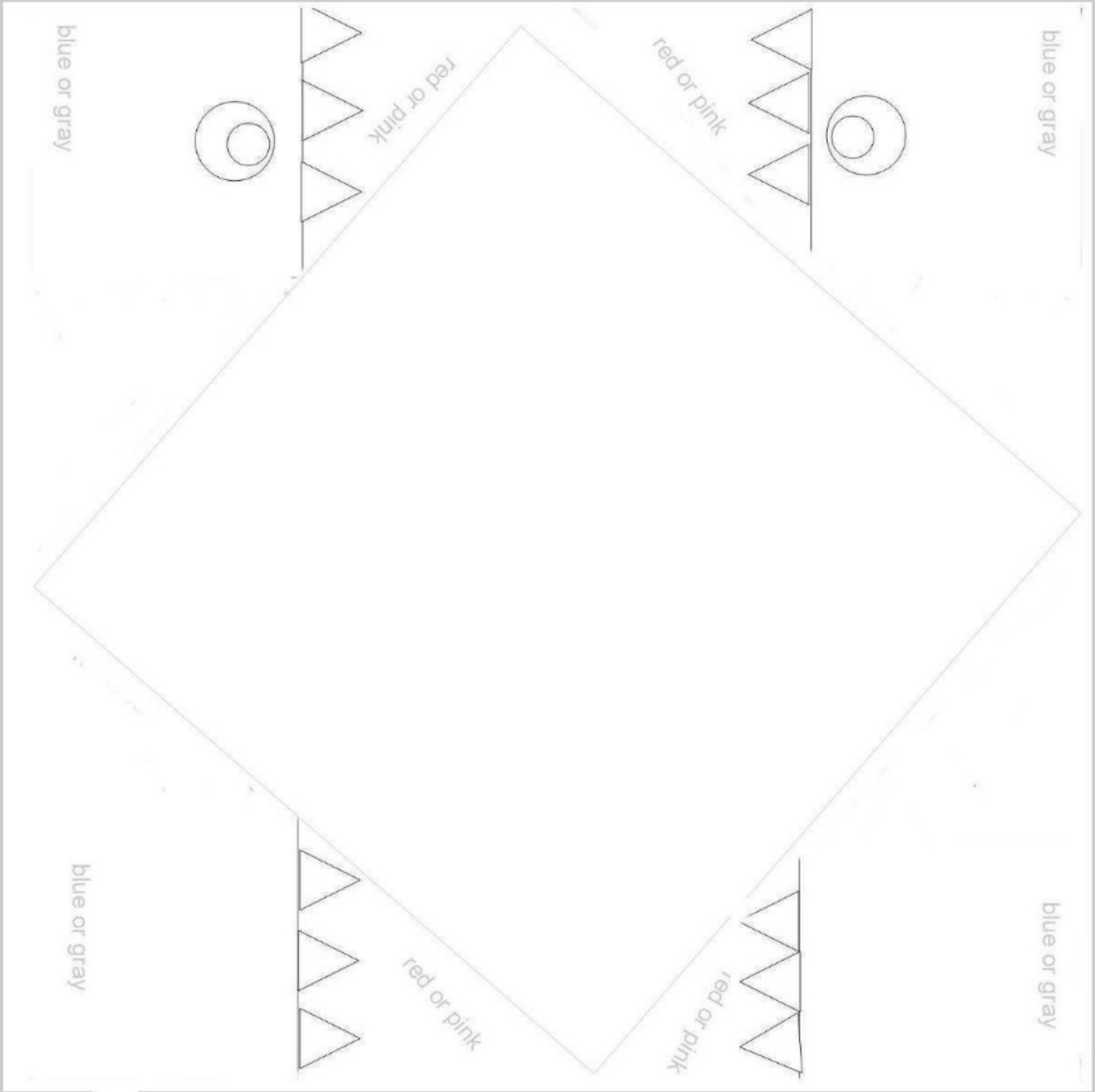
You can print the attached template to create a shark of your choice. Color gray and white for the legendary Great White, blue for the sleek Blue Shark, dark blue with white spots for the gentle giant Whale shark or add stripes for the strong Tiger shark.

Don't have a printer? No worries! Start your project with a square sheet of paper. To create a square from a regular 8.5 x 11 sheet of paper, take the left corner of the paper and fold it down to the right, making a crisp crease. Cut the rectangle shape off and you have your square.

Next, follow my steps on the instruction page to create your shark or other item of your choice.

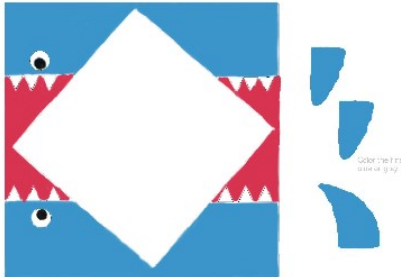

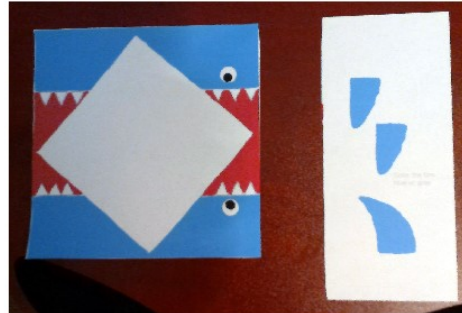


Color the fins
blue or gray

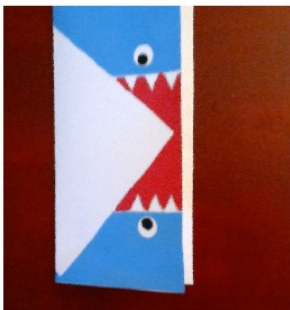
1. Print and color the template.



2. Cut out.



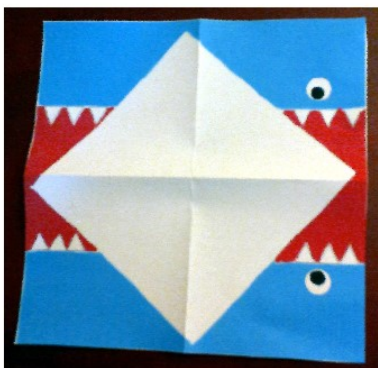
3. Fold.



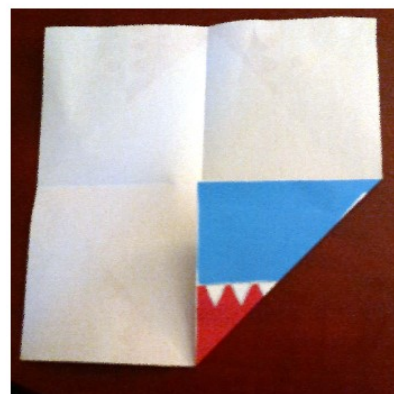
4. Fold again.



4. Open and flip over.



5. Fold each corner in.



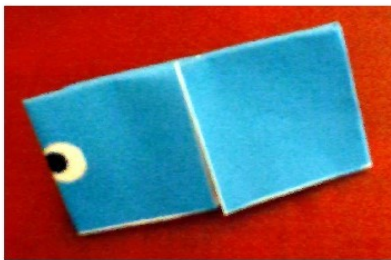
7. Finish all folds and flip over.



8. Fold each corner in again.



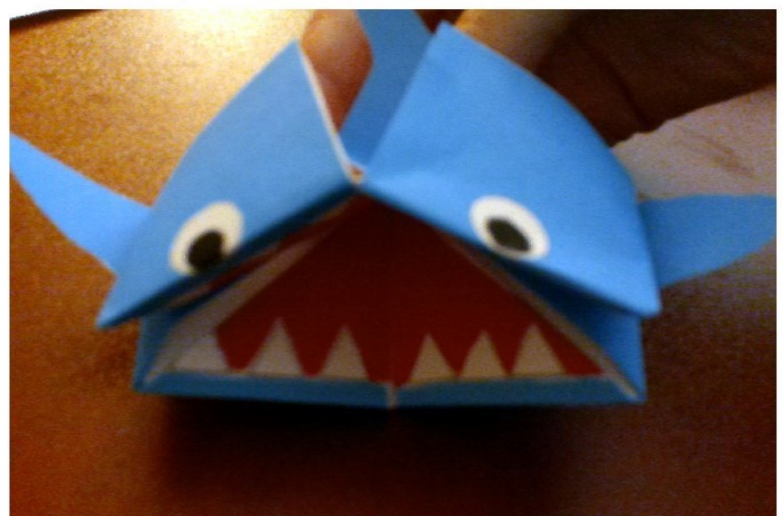
9. Fold in half.



10. Work fingers into the four corners of the folded side to open.



11. Cut out fins and tape or glue them to the shark.
