



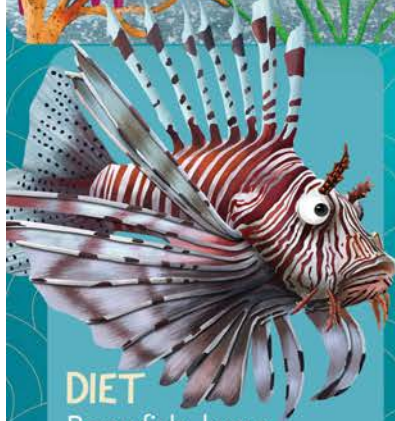

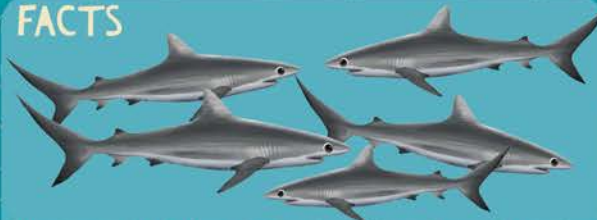

They give birth to live young (placental viviparity/viviparous) with an average litter size of 3-6 pups.

They are the primary species found on "shark feeds" in The Bahamas.

SIZE Can reach a length of 2.95 m (9.7 ft)
