CARCHARHINIDAE

THEY ARE COMMONLY FOUND
WORLDWIDE IN WARM,
SHALLOW WATERS
ALONG COASTS
AND IN RIVERS



**BULL SHARKS ARE BIG HEAVY
BODIED, MIGRATORY, LIVE-BEARING SHARKS!**

THEY ARE EURYHALINE, MEANING THEY CAN
WITHSTAND A WIDE RANGE OF
**SALINITIES AND HAVE
BEEN FOUND IN FRESHWATER,
ESTUARIES AND RIVERS!**



**PROPORTIONATELY,
THE BULL SHARK HAS THE
STRONGEST BITE OF ANY SHARK WHOSE JAW
STRENGTH HAS BEEN MEASURED**

**THE SHARK GROWS TO A MAXIMUM
LENGTH OF 11.5 FEET (3.5 METRES), BUT IS USUALLY
7.3-7.8 FEET (2.2-2.3 METRES) LONG!**
