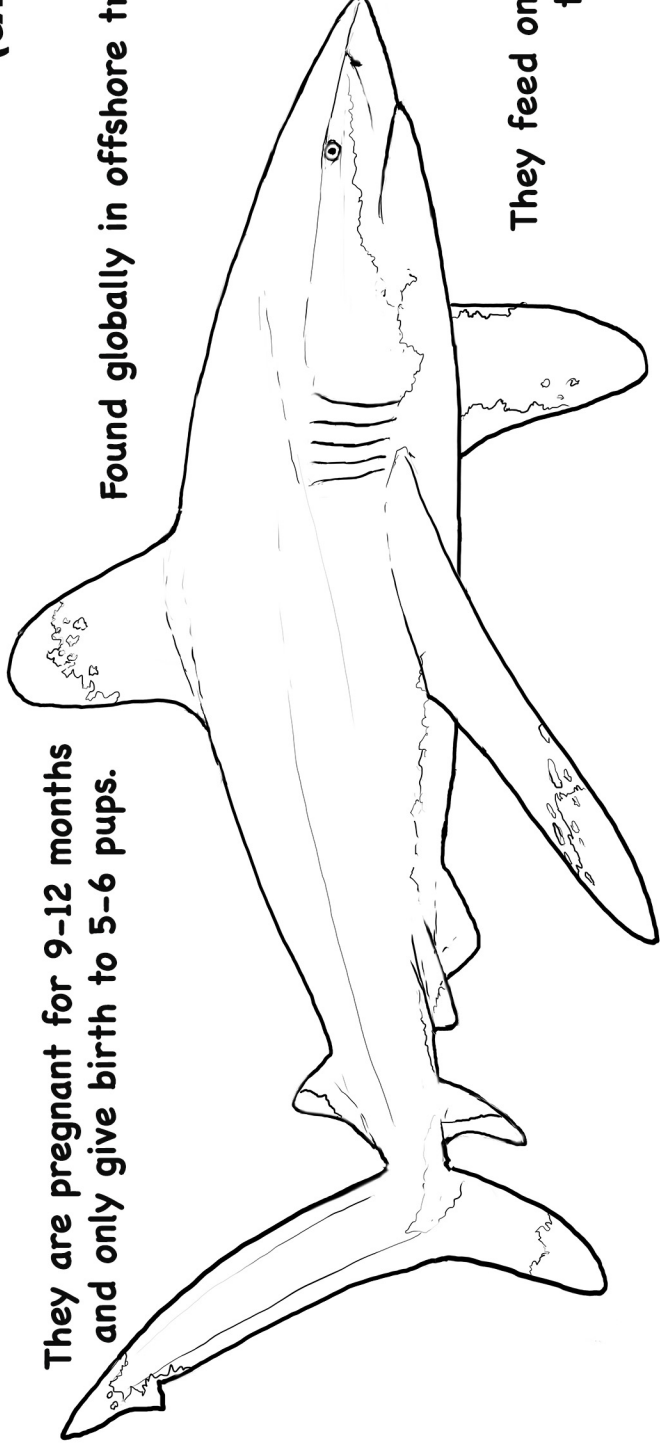




OCEANIC WHITETIP

(*CARCHARINUS LONGIMANUS*)

They are pregnant for 9-12 months and only give birth to 5-6 pups.



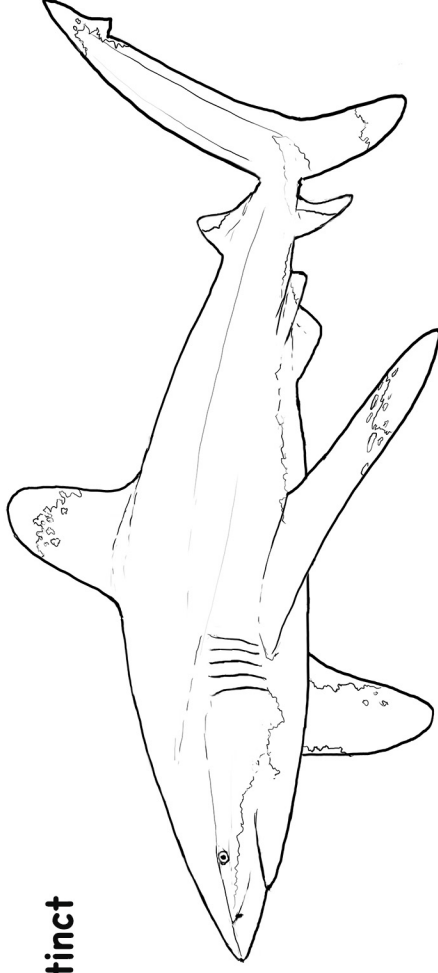
Found globally in offshore tropical and subtropical waters.

They feed on barracuda, mahi-mahi, marlin, tuna and mackerel.

Easily recognized by the rounded first dorsal with distinct white tip and long pectoral fins.

Listed as 'Vulnerable' on the IUCN Red List due to overfishing in pelagic fisheries around the world.

Listed 'Critically Endangered' in the western north and central Atlantic Ocean.



They migrate thousands of kilometers and play a critical role in open ocean ecosystems.
